### ADMISSIONS POLICY

Candidates seeking admission to Brillantmont International School should :

#### Stage 1

- Complete the application form found in the back of the school's prospectus or website, and return it, duly signed to the school.
- Pay the registration fee in order to open the admission procedure

#### Stage 2

- Complete and return the
  - Parent Questionnaire
  - Student / Parent Questionnaire
  - Principal / Counselor Questionnaire completed by the candidate's present school

and send,

- official School Reports for the past three years
- Graded English writing sample

#### Stage 3

In addition

American Section :

- Candidates, whose first language is not English, and who wish to enter the 11<sup>th</sup> grade are required to prove that they have reached an intermediate level in English. The following official test scores are accepted as proof :
  - SLEP test score of 53 or above
  - TOEFL internet-based score of 61
- It is inadvisable for candidates to change schools in their final year. However, in exceptional circumstances, we will consider candidates for our 12<sup>th</sup> grade. Candidates, whose first language is not English, are required to prove that they have reached a high intermediate level in English. Only the following official test is accepted as proof :
  - TOEFL internet-based score of 78
- Candidates who wish to enter our post-graduate Advanced Placement program must have successfully completed their High School studies and, in the case of candidates whose mother-tongue is not English, have attained a TOEFL internet-based score of 100.

British Section :

- Candidates who wish to enter Year 11 (the IGCSE year) will be considered for admission if they have successfully completed
  - the British Programme in Year 10
  - an educational system, other than British, which is recognised as being equivalent in standard to a Year 10 British programme of studies and, in the case of candidates whose mother-tongue is not English, have attained an internet-based TOEFL score of 61 or its equivalent.
- Candidates who wish to enter the A Level Programme will be considered for admission to Year 12 (the AS Year) if they have successfully completed
  - the British Programme in Year 11 and obtained a minimum of five (1)GCSE's with grades C or above (in the extended / higher level)
  - an educational system, other than British, and obtained a national school leaving certificate which is recognised as being equivalent in standard to the (1)GCSE and, in the case of candidates whose mother-tongue is not English, have attained an internet-based TOEFL score of 100 or its equivalent.
- It is inadvisable for candidates to change schools in their final year. However, in exceptional circumstances, we will accept qualified candidates for our Year 13 programme (the "A2" year).



Special Needs :

- The school does not discriminate against students with a physical handicap. However, due to the nature of our school buildings, candidates with a physical handicap are asked to contact the school prior to completing the application form to ensure that we will be able to accommodate their individual needs.
- The school does not have a Special Needs Specialist nor a Support Unit in the school. Candidates with mild learning disabilities are asked to include any reports documenting their individual needs with their application file, so that we can determine if the school can accommodate their needs.
- The school cannot accommodate students with specific / severe learning disabilities.
- The school cannot accommodate students of exceptionally high ability and/or exceptional talent

**Although an interview is not required , we recommend that every prospective student tries to visit the school.**
