ICT is an integral component of all courses.

11th and 12th graders can enrol on SAT and TOEFL preparation courses.

Students with the necessary academic background can choose Advanced level or AP courses in their freshman and senior years.

Brilliantmont International School American High School Graduation requirements :
A minimum of 20 academic credits including :

4 English credits	3 Mathematics credits (incl. Algebra 2)	1 fine arts credit
3 Science credits	2 Social Science credits	Proficiency in one foreign language

In addition to the 20 academic credits, a minimum Internet Based TOEFL score of 79 is required of all foreign students who wish to receive a graduation diploma. Those whose TOEFL lies between 61 and 78 will be awarded a graduation certificate.

Brilliantmont International School does not rank students or report cumulative GPA. Small class size, the high rate of student turnover in international schools and the wide variety of marking systems from which our students come make formal ranking inadvisable.
