

DRESS CODE POLICY

Brillantmont does not have a school uniform. However, students should be dressed appropriately for school. During the school day, we expect all students to dress neatly, meeting our expectations at all times. Most students choose to wear trousers and a shirt / top.

For everyday life:

- T-shirts
- sweatshirts
- sweaters (light and warm)
- shirts with a collar
- trousers, skirts, dresses
- shoes / boots / sandals (shoes must have a back to them)
- slippers for in the boarding house
- waterproof, warm jacket for winter
- hat, scarf, gloves

For your sports classes/ excursions:

- sports shoes
- non marking trainers for your sports classes
- tracksuit
- sports kit – leggings, sports shorts, sports t-shirt
- swimming costume

** New students receive the school branded sports kit, which they are expected to wear to sports classes. Returning students can purchase additional Brillantmont sports kit if needed.

For snow-related activities (skiing / sledging/ snow-shoe) and weekends:

- warm shoes/boots for winter that do not slip in the snow
- ski clothes – trousers, ski jacket, thermal layers, ski socks, ski gloves, hat
- sunglasses / ski goggles
- hiking shoes and thick socks
- ski equipment – boots, skis, poles and helmet can be hired through school. However, you are very welcome to bring your own, which will be stored in our ski room.

When representing the school (for example at MUN conferences)

- business attire (smart dress / trouser/skirt suit/ suit with a tie)

For school events /annual festivities:

- a smart outfit / special dress (cocktail or long) / suit with a tie for special events

Expectations concerning student appearance

Staff members have the right to ask a student to change his/her attire if it is unsuitable.

- No hats or coats to be worn in class or the dining room.
- Sport clothes are only to be worn when participating in sport.
- No facial piercings, including tongue, nose, eyebrows, or piercing such as spacers are permitted.
- No visible tattoos.
- No offensive language or designs on clothing.
- No visible underwear.
- No low-cut tops, strapless tops or tops with cut out backs.
- No clothes which are transparent and revealing.
- No ripped jeans.
- Bermuda shorts for boys or girls – but no sports shorts eg. basketball shorts, unless in sports class. High cut shorts are not appropriate.
- For girls – all skirts, shorts, dresses should be no shorter than the horizontal hand above the knee.
- No midriff showing.
- No high heels (over 6 cm)
- No flip flops, mules. All shoes should have a back to them.
